Dear ,

Cap Haitian is Haiti's second city. We set up in a field in a residential area and the crowd welcomed us. We were on two radio stations. For the week 262 people registered salvations in person, and 166 by text message. The new converts meeting the day after the crusade drew 67 new believers.

Rev. Church Paul from Nigeria and I preached alternate evenings. There were healing testimonies, and people were delivered. Saturday night I preached the baptism of the Holy Spirit to the entire crowd with great results.

Friday night a powerful rain squall knocked down our roof, our lights and dumped buckets of water for two hours. But we were back the following night. God is always moving.

We have a team of 24 missionaries:
Really they are evangelists, pastors and church planters. We

gather at each crusade and during the day we hear their testimonies and train them and impart spiritual gifts to them.

They raise the dead, so who am I to impart gifts to them? But Holy Spirit moves in these meetings and we all look forward spending time with each other in the presence of the Lord. This time, when Church Paul and I laid hands on each one I had a prophetic word for each person. This is a new gift for me, and I am praising God for it.

After the Big Rain, a beautiful sky. Every day is a good day to preach the gospel!
